The Office of Continuing Medical Education is pleased to announce a **full scholarship** available to the seventh annual Taos Writing Retreat for Health Professionals. The Taos Writing Retreat will be held at the historic Mabel Dodge Luhan House from August 6-12, 2006. The scholarship covers private room, meals, and all costs. Eligibility includes any UNM student in medicine, nursing, pharmacy, and allied health.

The Taos Writing Retreat is a seminar limited to sixteen people in the health professions—in various stages of their careers, from across the country—who come together united by a desire to write. The seminar aims to create an environment in which participants pursue their individual writing projects in a communal atmosphere conducive to creative work. Applicants for the scholarship must submit a statement (no more than 500 words) describing how they imagine they might use the time at Taos. A cover page must include your name, academic program, year of study, and campus address with email address. Applicants will be chosen based on quality of proposed use of time in Taos, overall quality of application, and seniority (in case of a tie, 4th years get some preference). **Deadline for applications is May 12.** The successful applicant will be notified by May 20.
