

Army Reserve Officer Training Corps

The Army Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC) provides an opportunity for college nursing students to receive practical, hands-on leadership experience. The courses offer a chance for students to develop management, communication, and decision-making skills in a nonthreatening environment. Physical training and confidence-building activities (i.e., rappelling, obstacle courses) also provide a chance for students to be physically and mentally challenged.

Students who are interested in obtaining a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) at the University of New Mexico may enroll in ROTC. Students may enroll as a freshman or sophomore with no risk or obligation. Upon completion of the program, students are commissioned as officers in the United States Army.
