The NROTC program has a variety of scholarship opportunities available, ranging from two to four years. The benefits include:

- Paid tuition costs
- Textbook voucher of \$375 per semester
- Paid labs fees
- Subsistence allowance starting at \$250 per month
- Commission in the Naval Nurse Corps
