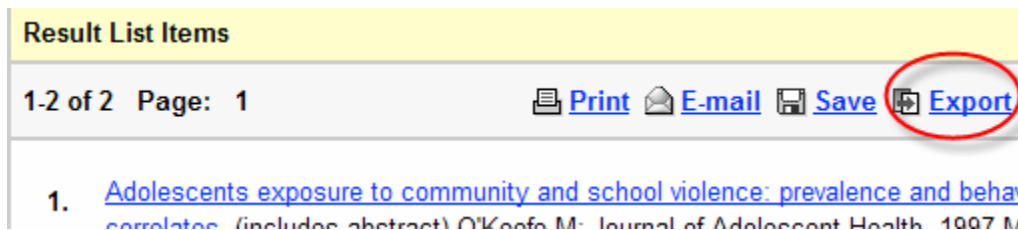
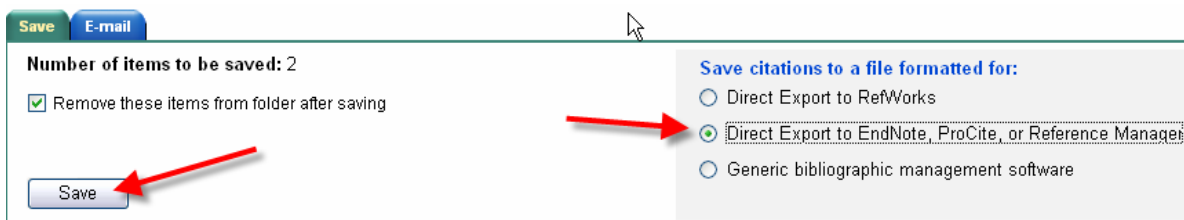


Capturing Citations From EBSCO databases into Endnote v.9

1. Run your search in CINAHL (or PsycINFO). Save your results by clicking on the folder icon next to the reference you are interested in.
2. When you have made all of your selections, click on the **Folder Has Items** icon at the top of the reference list on the right.
3. From the next screen select **Export**.



4. At the next screen, On the next screen, Click on “**Citations in Direct Export format**”, then click on **Save**.
5. NOTE: You might want to Unclick the box next to Remove these items from folder after saving until you are sure the citations are in your EndNote library.



6. If EndNote is loaded on the computer you are searching from, EndNote will automatically launch, and ask you to select the EndNote library you want your references downloaded into. Select the library you want and the references will appear in that library. The imported references will stay separate from the rest of your library until you close EndNote or click on the References pull down menu and select **Show All References**.
