Service Lines:

The Department of Emergency Medicine, which offers a 3 year Residency Program through the UNM School of Medicine, is responsible for the medical direction of the UNM Hospitals Emergency Center. The UNM Trauma Center is the only Level 1 Trauma Center for the State of New Mexico.

The Department of Emergency Medicine is also responsible for the Emergency Medical Services Academy, New Mexico Poison Control Center, Albuquerque Job Corps, Lifeguard Air Emergency Services, the Center for Injury Prevention Research and Education, Center for Disaster Medicine, and city and county rescue units.

The Department of Emergency Medicine is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and is located in the Southwest corner of UNMH.

ED East (Lower acuity prompt care) is open 7 days a week Monday-Friday from 8a-11p and Saturday and Sunday from 9a-10p. Staffed by Primary Care and Emergency Medicine Physicians

Pediatric Emergency Medicine is open 7 days a week M-F 2p-2a and Saturday and Sunday from 10a-2a. The Pediatric Emergency Department is the only Pediatric Emergency Department in the State of New Mexico staffed by specialists in Pediatric Emergency Medicine.
