## ALSO Provider Course

### Overall Course Objectives

- Discuss ways of improving the management of obstetrical urgencies and emergencies which may help standardize the skills of practicing maternity care providers;
- Discuss the importance of utilizing regional maternity care services and identify possible barriers which might limit access; and
- Successfully complete the course written test and megadelivery testing station.

Detailed educational objectives are listed at the beginning of each ALSO course syllabus chapter.

### Accreditation
