² Health Professions Programs include: Dental Hygiene, Med Lab Sciences, Physician Assistant, and Radiological Sciences (Emergency Medical Services, Occupational Therapy and Physical Therapy are listed separately due to tuition differentials).

³ The tuition differential is charged per credit hour for all hours, regardless of the number of hours taken. (15 hours is assumed for Undergraduate and 12 hours is assumed for Graduate).

⁴ The tuition differential is charged in the same manner as blocked tuition.
