Decision Tree

“On-campus” is defined as research that is conducted in facilities owned or leased/rented by the University and for which the University is bearing the costs. For space used for on-campus research, the University has already included the costs associated with that space in the “facilities” portion of the on-campus F&A rate.

“Off-campus” project is one that is one that is conducted (1) in leased facilities where space related costs are charged directly to the program, or (2) in facilities made available (at no cost) to the program by a non-University organization. If more than 50% of a project is performed off-campus, the off-campus rate will apply to the entire project.

Will the project be performed in facilities that are not owned, maintained, or rented/leased by UNM, and space related costs are charged directly to the project.

50% of the project period of performance is conducted in said facilities (above)
