**COVID-19 Vaccine Training Videos**

The New Mexico Immunization Program has developed six training videos to assist COVID-19 vaccine providers in reporting required information concerning COVID-19 vaccination in the New Mexico State Immunization Information System, or NMSIIS.

The six videos include instructions on: 1) Roles and Responsibilities; 2) Storage Unit Temperature Monitoring; 3) Storage, Handling and Preparation for Vaccine Products; 4) Reconciliation Reporting; 5) Patient Details with Services Reporting; and 6) Temperature Uploading. The videos are tabulated to allow providers to quickly identify the section(s) where they can find issues of interest.

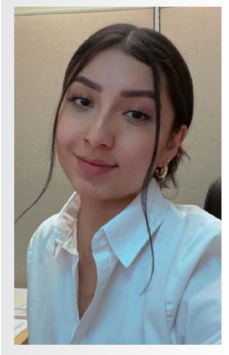

### Got Shots?

This year, Got Shots will be extended to over seven weeks! Events will take place from July 9 through the end of August. This will give parents and providers ample time to get children up to date on vaccines for school.

Providers, there is still time to sign up. While the deadline for incentives was June 10th, we are still accepting registrations. [Check our website](#) (or the QR code) to see which providers are

participating in your county and on which days/times. We have 66 providers signed up!

Got Shots is an opportunity for providers to serve the community by offering vaccines to any child 0-18, at no cost to the parent and without requiring insurance. We want to protect our communities from vaccine-preventable diseases, and keeping children up to date is an important component of that protection. With children back in-person for school and day care, we must be vigilant to make sure they are immunized.
