

# How to Find your Systems Hardware and Software Specification?



There are a few ways to find your devices hardware and software information. Below are a few methods on how to do so.

## Method 1

---

- **Right-click** on the **Start Menu** and select the **System** option. This will bring you to the **About** section of **Windows Settings**.



## Method 2



- Press the **Windows Key + Pause/Break** keys at the same time. This will bring you to the **About** section of **Windows Settings**.
  - If you are using a laptop, this method may require the use of the **FN** key to complete the key combination. Before pressing **Windows Key + Pause/Break**, hold down the **FN** key if the key combination does not work without it.

## Method 3

---

- Open the **Start Menu** and type **About your PC** in the search box. This will bring you to the **About** section of **Windows Settings**.



## Finding your Hardware Information

---

Information about your **Device Name, Processor (CPU), and Random Access Memory (RAM)** can be found in the **Device Specification** section of the **About** page. Ensure that your device meets the specifications listed at the beginning of this article before attempting the installation of Windows 11.

## Finding your Operating System Information

---

- Scroll down in the **About** section to **Windows Specification**.
- Ensure that your device currently meets the following:
  - **Edition**: Windows 10 Enterprise
  - **Version**: 22H2
  - **OS Build**: 19045.XXXX
