### Healthy and Fit Children's Clinic, Dr. Sylvia Negrete

- Why was it developed? In late 2000 Dr. Sylvia witness a child get stuck in a playground slide due to his size. She then went on to learn about childhood obesity. Since the early 70s, childhood obesity has almost tripled. In 2018, according to the NMDOH over a third of children in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade were obese. New Mexico also has a very high poverty rate. 1 in 4 families are receiving SNAP benefits.
- In 2009 she developed the children clinic that helps intervene in the lives of children and families at risk and dealing with obesity. The clinic evaluates children and provides education to families.
- Risks of obesity: cardiovascular risk factors, endocrine disorders, NAFLD, orthopedic problems, asthma, psychosocial problems.
- In 2013, a medical student rotating in the clinic noticed that when physical
  activity was prescribed by clinic doctors, the children and families often didn't
  have the resources to perform these activities. The Fit for Fun 5k was then
  established to help raise funds to solve this problem.
- In 2013, Fit for Fun 5k was started and got taken over by HSSC in 2016. The
  event has been taken over by Run Fit in 2021 and is put on by them. Run fit
  then donates the funds to the Healthy and Fit Children's Clinic.
- The funds helped supplement fitness tools for children and families, like providing bikes to families, putting on summer events on healthy activities and eating, and sending children to summer camp.
- The funds from the 5k also went to purchasing supplies for the clinic, such as food portion plates, posters, and healthy snacks for children.



- It is a referral clinic, so PCP's an refer children and families to the clinic. The children get a tool kit that contains a water bottle, a portion plate, and a jump rope to take home with them.
- Fit for Fun 5k to take place at an undetermined date in October of 2022

## Lexiam Heart Foundation a NM based non-profit, Courtney Grassham

- Have fun and run to help raise money to help New Mexico families who are the 1 in 100 with a baby born with a Congenital Heart Defect (CHD). 100% of the proceeds stay in New Mexico. The foundation was started by a mom who lost a child to CHD as well as a child who is living with CHD. The foundation helps pay for travel expenses for families, funds places to stay for families traveling for medical care, as well funeral costs for children with CHD who lost their lives. The foundation has given over \$75,000 to New Mexico families.
