

NM COP SCHOLARSHIPS

Definition: Scholarships provided to the College of Pharmacy through private donations by alumni and other benefactors.

Eligibility: Both need and merit based scholarships are available. Awarding policies can be subject to change from year to year, based on availability of funding and College of Pharmacy priorities. **Amount:** Depends on funding levels and number of qualified applicants.

To Apply: Complete the COP Scholarship Application (Sent to all students via email). Completion of the FAFSA is required for to determine financial need. Essays are required.

American Indian Graduate Center

Definition: Graduate fellowship for American Indian and Alaskan Native students from federally recognized tribes, provided by American Indian Graduate Center (AIGC) of Albuquerque, New Mexico.

Eligibility: Must be an enrolled member of a federally recognized American Indian tribe or Alaskan Native group in the United States or possess one-fourth degree (federally recognized) Indian blood. Must complete FAFSA.

Fees: There is a \$15 fee for first time applicants.

Amount: Depends on financial need and level of funding.

Deadline: Normally, early June (check with program).
