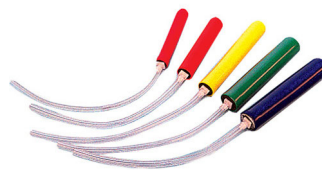

- ❖ 4-5 Applications (by mail or online) per week
- ❖ Same Day Shipping of AT
- ❖ NMTAP works with AgrAbility for any New Mexicans who are food cultivators with disabilities

Funding

- ❖ Federally funded by Office of Interagency Innovation, under U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. The State Grant for Assistive Technology (SGAT) provides funding for NMTAP.
- ❖ NMTAP does not accept insurance because it is a loaner program. NMTAP employees get paid by the state.
- ❖ Every year, they are allotted a small budget to purchase new equipment.
