Eligibility

- ✓ Must be dx with medically fragile condition before age 22
- ✓ Long-term medical condition that requires skilled care and assessment
- ✓ No waitlist

Services

- ✓ RNs case management service coordination for medically fragile children & their families
- ✓ Act as advocates, resource persons, facilitators, and paperwork coordinators for families
- ✓ Support parents as the team leaders in the daily care for their child & parent decision to care for their children in their home



Funding

- ✓ Children who qualify for the MFCMP are eligible to apply for Medicaid regardless of parent eligibility
- ✓ Medically Fragile Waiver
- ✓ Allows children to be eligible for more services
