Two new doctoral programs, the Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) and PhD in Nursing were implemented and students admitted. The first class of PhD and DNP graduated May, 2016.

DNP program completed the CCNE accreditation site visit and received the maximum initial accreditation from CCNE, the national accreditation body. All accreditation standards were met.
