Terms and Conditions

The Clinical & Translational Science Center (CTSC) is proud to present the **2024 CTSC BioVentue Partnership Event**, to be held on **September 13, 2024**, from **2:00 - 5:30 pm** at the Student Union Building on the UNM Campus in Albuquerque, NM, and is governed by the following Terms and Conditions.

By participating in the 2024 BioVenture, you ("Participant(s)") agree to abide by the following Terms and Conditions and directives by the BioVenture Organizers:

1. Eligibility

Students, faculty, and community members are invited to participate. As a UNM HSC-hosted event, BioVenture will adhere to UNM standards and policies. Participants agree to follow these policies and standards for the duration of the event.

2. Use of Proprietary Information

Participants represent and authorize that they have permission to use their proprietary assets during BioVenture and that it does not infringe on the intellectual property or proprietary rights of any third party, including, without limitation, any third party, patents, copyrights, or trademarks.

3. Publicity and Privacy

Except where prohibited, by participating in BioVenture, Participant understands that the event may be photographed, videotaped, recorded, etc. and hereby grants the Planning Committee the right to use or refrain from using Participant's name and/or likeness any and all footage about Participant's participation at BioVenture in any manner or media (including but not limited to social media outlets) that the Planning Committee sees fit without Participant's review or approval and without compensation.

5. Intellectual Property Rights

Intellectual property (IP) rights brought into BioVenture are considered background IP and are owned by the participants, or the organization that may have rights. Inventions arising from participation at BioVenture are subject to follow NIH policies, specific to citing the CTSC grant.

6. General

The Planning Committee reserves the right, in their sole discretion, to cancel, modify or suspend BioVenture in whole or in part, in the event of fraud, technical or other difficulties or if the integrity of BioVenture is compromised, without liability to the Participants. The Planning Committee reserves the right to disqualify any Participant, as determined by the Planning Committee, in their sole discretion.

7. Code of Conduct

The CTSC BioVenture Partnership Event is committed to providing a safe and welcoming space, without regard to age, gender, race, ethnicity, nationality, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, mental or physical disability, physical appearance, neuro(a)typicality, religion, socioeconomic status or background, political affiliation, or any other attribute.
