Other highlights and updates since our Winter Edition:

- We are now comprised of 6 full time faculty physicians and 2 Advanced Practice Providers (PA-C and NP) at the UNMH clinic and one full time faculty physician at the VA site, with 4 jointly appointed faculty in Internal Medicine/ Allergy-Immunology, Family-Community Medicine and Pathology. We are interviewing for additional VA faculty and will be developing services at the UNM Comprehensive Cancer Center this summer. We plan to further expand our breadth of clinical expertise by continuing to grow our faculty over the next two years.
- With the amazing energy and leadership of Dr. Emily Altman, and the organized assistance of our administrative staff (Mary "Liz" Torres, Lalita Lopez de Gauntt and Katharine Rebolledo) we sailed through a flurry of activity as we hosted the ACGME site visit (Jan 2018), learned of our accreditation status (April 2018) and completed two interview sessions (April and May) for 2018 and 2019 residency candidates. Our goal for the new training program is to be recognized as one of the best in the nation.
- We are continuing to expand our Teledermatology services and anticipate new contracts and a budding partnership with outlying communities in New Mexico, via Preceptorship in Medicine rural experiences for medical students.
- Grand Rounds will increase to weekly sessions as of July 2018, for CME credit, and we have booked nationally
 recognized speakers for the upcoming year. A special thank you to Dr. Deb Atkins (UNM SOM '01) and Epiphany
 Dermatology for their donations specifically helping to sponsor Grand Rounds this year.

If you live locally, please plan to come meet and welcome the faculty, new residents and administrative staff at my home on the afternoon of Saturday August 18th (see below for details). For all of you, I thank you again for your continued support and encouragement. We have made tremendous strides and will continue to do so in this upcoming academic year.
