### FREE STATEWIDE SKIN CANCER SCREENINGS

Dr. John Durkin has done an amazing job mobilizing interested students, trainees and faculty this year, starting a sustainable program to direct preventive screenings throughout New Mexico. The program was launched with the support of the Shannon J. Shaw Memorial Fund and in partnership with the UNM Comprehensive Cancer Center. The UNMH Dermatology Clinic hosted a free skin cancer screening in early May 2019 in Albuquerque for Melanoma Awareness Month. This was the second screening of the program after a very successful event held in Carlsbad in December 2018. 160 patients were screened at the local event and educated on the signs and symptoms of skin cancer as well as on measures for prevention.

The next screening will take place tentatively on Saturday, August 24th in Gallup, NM. Other targeted locations include Northern New Mexico/Taos and Las Vegas. The goal of this screening is to bring skin cancer awareness and specifically will try to highlight areas with few or no dermatologists. We plan to repeat this program yearly.
