Department Updates





FREE SKIN CANCER SCREENINGS 2022-2023

Taos NM: April 1, 2023

We have continued our free skin cancer screenings including most recently in Taos in April and in Rio Rancho and Albuquerque in May for Melanoma Awareness Month. All screenings had amazing turn-outs. 32 patients were seen in Taos, 67 were seen in Rio Rancho and 132 were seen in Albuquerque. 1/3 of patients seen needed a follow up, meaning they had a lesion or concerns for cancer or precancer.

3RD ANNUAL DERMATOLOGY FOR PRIMARY CARE CONFERENCE JUNE 3, 2023




A Tribute To A Pioneer of UNM Dermatology
