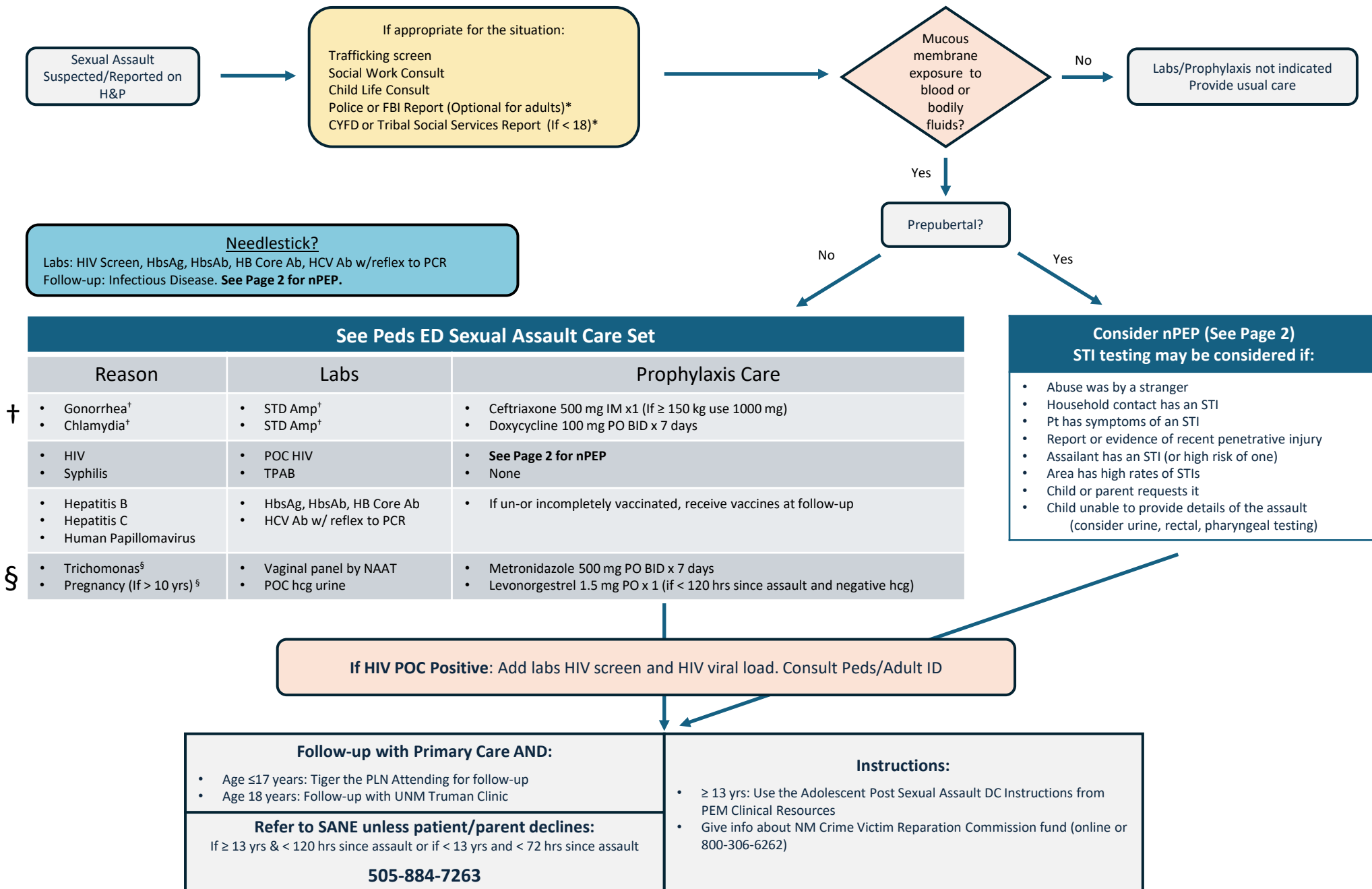

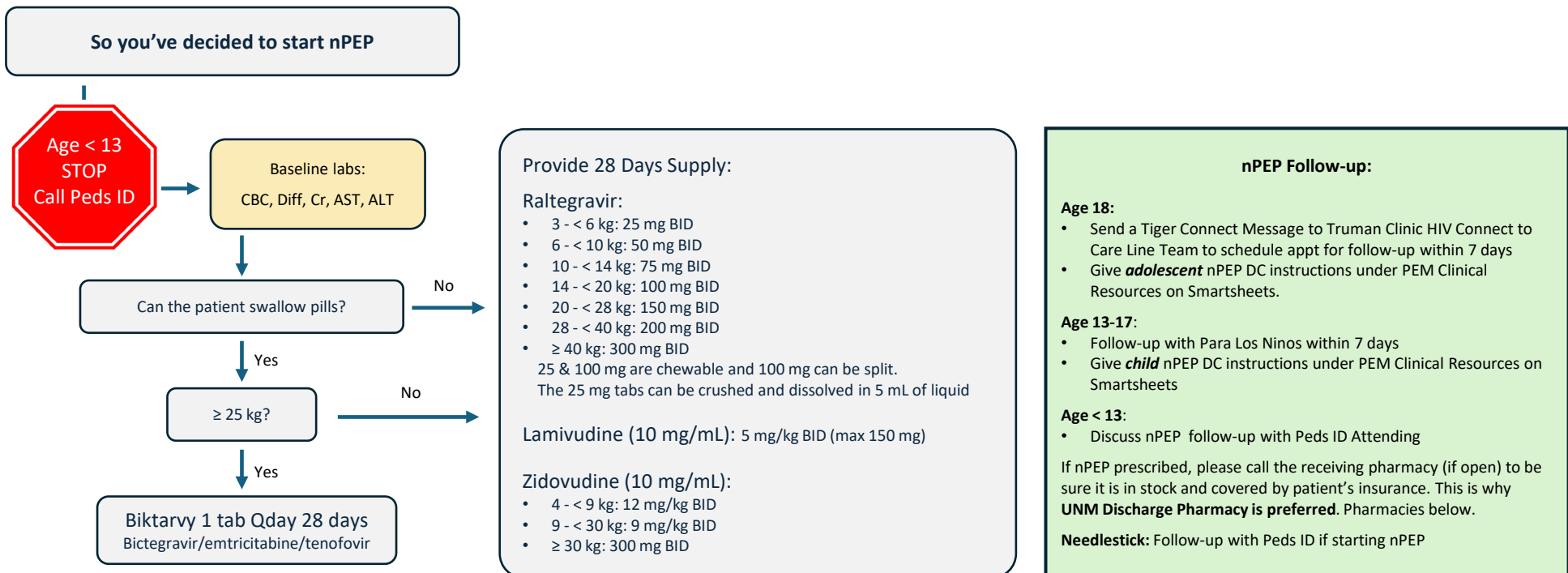

HIV Post-Exposure Prophylaxis

National Clinician Post Exposure Prophylaxis PEPlne (888) 448-4911

High Risk <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Exposure of: Mucous membranes, non-intact skin, percutaneous contact With: Blood, semen, vaginal secretions, rectal secretions, breast milk, or any bodily fluid visibly contaminated with blood 	≤ 72 hrs since exposure	Source has HIV	nPEP recommended
	> 72 hrs since exposure	Source unknown	Case-by-case Needlesticks fall here but generally not recommended
Low Risk <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Exposure of: Mucous membranes, non-intact skin, percutaneous contact With: Urine, nasal secretions, saliva, sweat, tears 			nPEP NOT recommended
