Data presented in the table is collected from a voluntary survey sent to cohort graduates 6 months following program completion/graduation. Numbers and percentages reflect cohort graduate data available via surveys and other sources (alumni records, updates from alumni, etc.).

Definitions:

- NM Resident: NM Resident upon starting the program. Students who have physically resided in New Mexico for at least 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the submission of their application, or; who graduated from a New Mexico high school, but have been out of the state for the specific purpose of educational enrichment at an accredited institution or active military service, or; who are enrolled members of an American Indian nation, tribe and pueblo, located wholly or partially in New Mexico.
- Rural or Frontier Location: Location as determined by data.HRSA.gov, Rural Health Grants Eligibility Analyzer.
- Medically Underserved: Service as determined by data.HRSA.gov, MUA Find.
- Primary Care: Care area as determined by NIH and ABMS. (Family Medicine, Internal Medicine, OG/GYN, Pediatrics)
- % Graduated: Calculated based on the number of students who have graduated at the time this data was last updated divided by the number of newly matriculated students in cohort.
