RISING STAR

This award is granted to a graduate of the last 10 years who has shown a commitment to teaching, clinical education, and contributing to the profession of physical therapy. It was presented to Heather Armijo, PT, DPT, for her contributions to pediatric physical therapy care and education.



GOLDEN ALUMNA

This award recognizes a previous UNM PT Distinguished Alumni of the Year awardee who continues to make contributions to the field of physical therapy. It was presented to Major Michelle A. Jílek, USAF, BSC for her innovations in preventive and curative care for Air Force pilots, focusing on high-G induced injuries of the spine.



GOLDEN PHYSICAL THERAPIST

This award recognizes a physical therapist who has made or continues to make significant contributions to the field of physical therapy in New Mexico. It was presented to Ron Andrews, PT, PhD, for his time as UNM PT Program faculty and Director, during which he saw the program through growth and the transition to an MPT



degree. He also worked with UNM's internationally-known Project ECHO, and assisted with New Mexico's Rural Health Initiative.
