#### **Cost of Clinical Component**

The financial estimate includes \$3200 for the clinical component of the program. The clinical education component of the UNM Physical Therapy curriculum will require travel outside of Albuquerque or New Mexico for one or two clinical rotations. The costs associated with housing, travel and transportation are borne by the student. These costs vary considerably depending upon location, but an estimated average is \$100-\$400 per week for each 9-week rotation.

#### **Computer Requirements**

The financial estimate includes \$1500 for a required personal computer. All students entering the Physical Therapy Program must have their own laptop computer. Your personal computer will be a necessary tool during your physical therapy education. Beyond the obvious benefits of the computer for word processing and organizational tasks, etc. all faculty and students will communicate via the UNM Health Sciences Center's electronic mail system (HSC link).
