To assist and support those who provide positive and affirming support to individuals with intellectual/developmental disabilities (I/DD) who also have mental health concerns and/or challenges.

#### **DDMI Clinic Collaboration**

DDMI Clinics originated in Taos, NM in collaboration with Tri-County Community Services and Los Angelitos y Enuseños (formerly the Taos ARC).

The DDMI Clinics continue as a collaborative effort between the Developmental Disabilities Supports Division (DDSD) and UNM (CoC, TEASC). The intent is to develop ongoing supports for people with I/DD to get the mental health services they need in their local communities.

### **Our Clinics:**

- Convene every two (2) months via secure online video connection to provide consultation to individuals, provider agencies, families/guardians
- Provide assessments, recommendations and strategies designed to improve support and care.
- Encourage team participation to increase education for all who are involved
- Can conduct re-assessments to determine if recommendations were helpful or need to be adjusted

#### Who can attend DDMI Clinics?

Those with I/DD residing in New Mexico (outside of Bernalillo county) can access the DDMI Clinic. Individuals, family members/guardians, case managers, direct support professionals, behavior support consultants and therapists are encouraged to attend the clinical session.
