- Deadline First Friday in April or as announced each semester
- Application Packet – Upload jpg photo of yourself.

 - Academic Dishonesty Form
- 3 References
 - Reference Forms
 - Letters of Recommendation (Each reference should include the reference form)
- All transcripts **If current UNM student, unofficial copies. LoboTrax is acceptable (w/ cumulative GPA of 2.5+). Official transcripts are required for other schools.
- Current grades for courses in progress in Fall/Spring semester of application (Note from instructors with current grade)
- Letter of Intent, address to the Nuclear Medicine Selection Committee on way you wish to be accepted to the Nuclear Medicine Program
- Experience working with patients in a medical setting (nuclear medicine applicants should complete 40 hours of observation in a nuclear medicine department)
 - Observation Log Sheet
