

- Traditional Route
 - Apply anytime after earning fouryear college degree



- UNM Combined BA/MD Program
 - Apply senior year of high school

What is the Combined BA/MD Degree Program?

8-year Partnership degree program between the College of Arts & Sciences and the UNM School of Medicine

Designed to help alleviate

New Mexico's physician shortage, especially in our rural and medically underserved areas


Admits 28 high school seniors every year

BA/MD Eligibility

In order to be considered applicants MUST...



Be a New Mexico resident



Be a current New Mexico high school senior



Meet a minimum ACT or SAT score

ACT: 22 Math, 19 Science, 19 Reading and 19 English

SAT: 510 Math, 450 Critical Reading

- Tests offered several times each year



Date	Application
August 1 st ····································	Opens
1 st Thursday of November (at 5:00pm)	Closes
November - February	Interviews
April 1 st	Applicants notified of BA/MD admissions decision (Accepted, Waitlisted or Declined)
May 1 st	Applicant Decision (Accept or Decline BA/MD offer)

- All <u>completed</u> applications are reviewed
- Applicants are <u>evaluated</u> on <u>cognitive</u> and <u>non-cognitive</u> criteria
- Eligible applicants who complete the application by the deadline will be <u>invited to</u> <u>interview</u>

In 4,000 characters or less discuss:

- Motivation for a career in medicine
- Diversity of your background and how it has influenced your goals and prepared you for a career in medicine
- Understanding of cultural diversity

- Committee members may be MDs, PhDs, medical students, UNM staff, and Albuquerque community members




BA/MD Provisional Admittance

Students with the following test scores are admitted provisionally and may be required to attend a summer session before starting college.

Foundations of Science

- Math 121 + HMHV 150
 - ACT Math 25 or below
 - SAT Math less than 620
- HMHV 150
 - Composite ACT 25 or below
 - Composite SAT 1150 or below
 - Must complete with C or better to continue with program



Admitted BA/MD Students

BA/MD students meet the following requirements to continue in the program.

- 3.37 cumulative GPA
- 3.0 Pre-Med GPA
- Meet UNM School of Medicine minimum MCAT Score
