CONFERENCE DESCRIPTION

The 29th Annual Amazing Newborns Conference, titled Figuring It Out from Day One: Challenges in the Newborn Period", is aimed at providing healthcare professionals tools and skills to assess the need for pharmacological verses non-pharmacological interventions for babies diagnosed with Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome (NAS). Additional presentations will focus on emerging evidence of the safety of breastfeeding while in drug treatment, clarifying the use of high-flow nasal-cannula to mimic nasal CPAP (nCPAP) in the neonate, and providing updated information on effective reading of ECG's in the newborn.

CONFERENCE OBJECTIVES

At the conclusion of this conference, the participant should be able to:

- 1. Formulate a bedside and long-term care plan for babies diagnosed with neonatal syphilis.
- 2. Assess the need for pharmacological verses non-pharmacological interventions for babies diagnosed with Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome (NAS).
- 3. Select the best mode of non-invasive respiratory support for neonates in respiratory distress.
