CONFERENCE DESCRIPTION

The 32nd Annual Amazing Newborns Conference, titled **Advocating for the Next Generation**, focuses on the impact and treatment of substance disuse on newborns and their families. Day two of the conference explores identifying and treatment of newborns born with possible lifelong medical conditions. Included in this year's conference are 2-30 minute "Treat Now!" talks, aimed at giving providers information on how to identify and treat conditions that require immediate care to prevent long-term complications. The breakout session will focus on skills needed for assessment and stabilization.

CONFERENCE OBJECTIVES

At the conclusion of this conference, the participant should be able to:

- 1. Identify mothers with opioid substance disuse and divert them into treatment using trauma informed care approaches.
- 2. Correctly manage exposed intestines in babies with gastroschisis.
- 3. identify early signs of neonatal encephalopathy and initiate initial steps to maximize positive outcomes.
