

Scholarships Available for Taos Writing & Wellness Retreat for Health Professionals

We are pleased to announce one scholarship for one eligible HSC student and one scholarship for an eligible SOM student/house officer/faculty/staff member to attend the 21st Annual Taos Writing & Wellness Retreat for Health Professionals. The retreat will take place at the Mabel Dodge Luhan house in Taos, NM from Sunday, July 31 to Saturday, August 6, 2022. Each of the available scholarships covers tuition, and room and board for 6 nights at the Mabel Dodge Luhan house. **Travel to/from Taos is the only expense not covered.**

Eligibility:

Student scholarship - This scholarship is open to students of the UNM Health Sciences Center, including students from the College of Nursing, the School of Medicine, the College of Pharmacy, and the Health Professions Program. SOM students may apply for both scholarships, but obviously will only be awarded one of the two.

School of Medicine scholarship - This scholarship is open to medical students, health professions program students, residents, fellows, and SOM faculty. SOM students may apply for both scholarships, but obviously will only be awarded one of the two.

Application process:

- (1) Interested applicants should write a statement of interest in 500 words or less, discussing why they wish to attend the retreat, and how it will help them in their career and/ or with their life goals.
- (2) Applicants should email their statement of interest to Dr. Liz Lawrence at Elawrence@salud.unm.edu on or before ~~May 1, 2022~~ **EXTENDED TO JUNE 1, 2022**.
- (3) Approval from applicants' program to attend the retreat if they are awarded the scholarship must be sent along with the statement of interest. Applicants should have their program director or other school designee sign the statement below and include this with their application.
