

Scholarship Available for Taos Writing & Wellness Retreat for Health Professionals

We are pleased to announce a scholarship for one eligible HSC learner to attend the 24th Annual Taos Writing & Wellness Retreat for Health Professionals. The retreat will take place at the Mabel Dodge Luhan house in Taos, NM from Sunday, August 3 to Saturday, August 9, 2025. The scholarship covers tuition, and room and board for 6 nights at the Mabel Dodge Luhan house. **Travel to/from Taos is the only expense not covered.**

Eligibility:

This scholarship is open to residents and fellows of the UNM School of Medicine.

Application process:

- (1) Interested applicants should write a statement of interest in 500 words or less, discussing why they wish to attend the retreat, and how it will help them in their career and/or with their life goals.
- (2) Applicants should email their statement of interest to Dr. Liz Lawrence at <u>Elawrence@salud.unm.edu</u> on or before **May 1, 2025.**
- (3) Approval from applicants' program to attend the retreat if they are awarded the scholarship must be sent along with the statement of interest. Applicants should have their program director or other school designee sign the statement below and include this with their application.
