

LOCATION REPORT 2016

University of New Mexico School of Medicine-Trained MDs



The Location Report is produced annually by the Office of Program Evaluation, Education and Research at the University of New Mexico School of Medicine. This report provides a statistical overview of current location information for UNM-trained physicians who were licensed to practice in New Mexico in the past year. This is the data as of June 2016.

QUICK FACTS:

Who was licensed to practice medicine in New Mexico in 2015?

- There were 1838 UNM-trained MDs licensed to practice in New Mexico in 2015 (page 5)
- Approximately 38% of all physicians licensed in New Mexico trained at UNM (1838/4788, page 5)
- Slightly more than one-third of physicians who graduated from UNM's medical school are licensed to practice medicine in New Mexico (37.9%, page2)
- Slightly more than one-third of physicians who completed their residency at UNM are licensed to practice medicine in New Mexico (38.5%, page2)
- Almost two-thirds of physicians who both attended medical school in New Mexico and completed their medical residency at UNM are licensed to practice in New Mexico (65.7% page 2)
- UNM-trained MDs are licensed to practice in 30 of New Mexico's 33 counties (page 4)

2015 Specialty Information

- Roughly half of all UNM-trained MDs in New Mexico are licensed to practice in the primary care specialties of family medicine, internal medicine, obstetrics & gynecology, or pediatrics (977/1838 total UNM-trained MD's in NM, page 7)
- About 24% of UNM-trained MDs in New Mexico are licensed to practice in one of four specialties: anesthesiology, general surgery, emergency medicine, or psychiatry (432/1838, page 8)

About UNM School of Medicine

- UNM School of Medicine graduated its first class of MDs in 1968 (see notes on terminology below)
- Before the UNM School of Medicine was created in 1962, there were residencies at the former Bernalillo County Indian Hospital (currently University of New Mexico Hospital), with the first residents graduating in 1955
- On average, there are 400 medical students and 590 medical residents and fellows in training at the UNM School of Medicine
- Each year approximately 100 medical students graduate and 180 medical residents and fellows complete their training at the UNM School of Medicine

A Note on Terminology:

All MDs who graduated from UNM School of Medicine or who completed all or part of their residency at UNM are referred to as **UNM-trained MDs**.


UNM-trained MDs fall into three mutually exclusive categories:

- MD degree from UNM, Medical Residency out-of-state (**MD Only**)
- Medical Residency at UNM, MD degree out-of-state (Medical Residency Only)
- Both MD degree and Medical Residency at UNM (MD and Medical Residency)

Figure 2: UNM-Trained MDs Licensed to Practice in New Mexico




Figure 3: UNM-Trained MDs Licensed to Practice in Primary Care Specialties in New Mexico




Figure 4: UNM-Trained MDs Licensed to Practice in New Mexico by County, 2015



Location Report: The Approach and Methods

Our intent with this report is to provide the best available information about UNM-trained physicians who were licensed to practice in New Mexico in the past year. It is important to note that any recent relocation by these individuals may not be reflected in our data.

To be included in this report, the following conditions must have been met:

The basis for including individuals in the Location Report:

- 1) The physician has a Medical Doctor (MD) degree
- 2) The physician is a UNM School of Medicine and/or Graduate Medical Education graduate
- 3) The physician has an active license from the New Mexico Medical Board
- 4) The physician had a New Mexico address during the previous year

The list of "UNM-trained physicians" consists of all UNM School of Medicine MD recipients from 1968 through 2015 and all physicians who completed their medical residencies in New Mexico from 1955 through 2015. The lists of University of New Mexico School of Medicine MD recipients (since 1968) and former residents (since 1955) were obtained from the University of New Mexico School of Medicine's Office of Student Services and the Office of Graduate Medical Education, respectively.
