The BSGP has not historically admitted international students to our MS program. This is because of the competitiveness of the MS applicant pool, cost of attendance, and structure of the program. We DO NOT recommend that international students apply to the MS program without talking to <u>the BSGP</u> <u>Director</u> first.

The BSGP does not offer assistantships or funding to MS students during the first year of the program. This means, if you are offered admission and receiving either an F-1 or J-1 visa, you will be responsible for showing available funding for the full cost of attendance, at one time, for the entire year.

Please see the Global Education Office (GEO) website for estimated <u>cost of attendance</u>. Note, GEO's estimate is for 9 credit hours. Our full time MS students take 28 credit hours in the first year of the program. <u>Using 2022 tuition and fee rates</u>, without the Amigo scholarship, cost of tuition and fees for the BSGP is closer to \$54,000 for the year, making total cost of attendance closer to \$74,000. Note: International applicants do not meet the Amigo scholarship deadline due to the structure of our BSGP Admissions cycle.

If you believe you can demonstrate available funding for the full cost of attendance, obtain the necessary visa to study in the USA, and move to the USA in the August before Fall classes start, please reach out to SOMREO at <u>somreo@salud.unm.edu</u> to discuss your application BEFORE APPLYING. Once you pay your application fee, it cannot be reimbursed under any circumstance.
