


What is the CTN Program?

- A nationwide collaborative funded by the National Institute on Drug Abuse (NIDA) to unite with medical and specialty treatment providers, researchers, and patients
- The Southwest CTN Node works to increase practicebased research by partnering with clinical sites

Practice-based research facilitates the integration of evidence-based treatment into standard clinical care much sooner than with traditional research models.

What CTN offers:

- Funding and research staff support for conducting practice-based research at your clinic
- CTN's team will support all levels of research activities including working with the IRB, training, quality assurance, and study implementation
- Opportunities to connect with other specialty providers, researchers, and patients who share overlapping interests and goals


