

## FAMILY NURSE PRACTITIONER CONCENTRATION

Below are instructions for adding a 3<sup>rd</sup> party (a student clinician) to a telehealth visit.

### DOXIMITY

- 1) Once the call has been initiated, to add a third participant (another patient, doctor, nurse, resident, etc.) to your call:
  - Tap the Share button in the top right corner of the call screen.
  - This will prompt you to share the video call URL via text or email.

### ZOOM FOR HEALTHCARE

- 1) Send the same link you send to the patient to the student clinician. You can add them as a co-host, which will allow them to share screen with the patient if need be.

### DOXY.ME

- 1) Use the [group calling](#) feature to have multiple providers on a call together on doxy.me [Professional](#) and [Clinic](#) accounts:
  - Patient checks into provider A's waiting room
  - Provider B checks into provider A's waiting room, just like a patient
  - Provider A starts group call with both the patient and provider B

If the practice allows, students should receive a student login for remote access to the EMR so they can view patient records. This can be performed remotely with a secure connection such as Cisco, AnyConnect Mobile Client, or Pulse Secure.
