Psychiatrists, psychologists, and mental health counselors offer child, adolescent, and adult psychiatry, child counseling, and medication monitoring and management.
- Eligibility Criteria: Patients can either self-refer for an intake or a referral can be placed by a primary care provider. Patients will initially be scheduled with an intake counselor to guide appropriate treatment and internal referrals.

- Services Provided: Inpatient, residential treatment center providing comprehensive psychiatric care as well as substance use treatment.
- Eligibility Criteria: Males 14-18 with history of behavioral health conditions including substance use disorder. Primary care providers, school counselors, and parents may refer students for care. Capacity is limited to 12 students at a time. Referrals can be emailed to [alobato@amikids.org](mailto:alobato@amikids.org). Students must undergo comprehensive screening at intake to ensure the safety of staff and other students. Students with overt violence history will be denied admission. Inpatient therapy may last weeks or months depending on treatment plan. The goal is to prevent incarceration and return students to their families when possible. Comprehensive care planning with CYFD involvement when appropriate. Other services include group therapy, individual and family counseling, and psychotherapeutic interventions.

Patients with Alcohol use disorder and opioid use disorder are accepted on a case-by-case basis depending on medical comorbidities.
