- Eligibility Criteria: Inpatient Adult Psychiatric Division intake criteria includes voluntary, involuntary, and court-ordered behavioral health treatment to individuals, ages 18 and older, suffering from a major mental illness that severely impairs their functioning, their ability to be maintained in the community, and who present as an imminent danger to self and/or others. An extensive admission interview occurs with the evaluating clinician and the preliminary clinical information is used to complete the initial treatment plan. Other team members complete a discipline-specific assessment within 72 hours and these assessments are then utilized in developing a master treatment plan with the participation of the patient within 7 days after the completion of the Initial Treatment Plan. This time period allows the team to become

more familiar with the patient's particular strengths and individual treatment needs while identifying discharge criteria that will continue to be assessed throughout the course of treatment. The Forensic Division admits individuals referred to the facility that have been charged with at least one felony-level offense and are in need of treatment to attain competency to proceed with adjudication.
