



Resolving Holds at UNM

- Registration for UNM classes cannot be completed until all holds are resolved.
- Use LoboWeb to check on any holds you may have:
 - a. Login to my.unm.edu using your NetID and Password
 - b. Access LoboWeb
 - c. Within LoboWeb, select the “Student” tab
 - d. Select “Registration and Records”
 - e. Select “View Holds”
- Please have your UNM ID number ready when contacting any UNM office.
 - “Incomplete Admissions” submit final transcripts to [UNM Admissions](#)
 - “Bursar” hold contact the [UNM Bursar](#)
 - “Orientation” hold register for a UNM [New Student Orientation](#)
 - As a dual degree BSN student, you have a specific orientation for students in your program. It is online and self-paced. If you do not see this as your UNM Orientation option, check back in a few days. It is a manual process to connect students to this fully online option. If you have already registered for a different orientation, please let me know via email at hsc-con-advising@salud.unm.edu - Please be sure to include your UNM ID number and the program you’ve been accepted into.
 - “Advisement” holds will be resolved by your College of Nursing advisor as part of our internal process. You do not have to meet with your advisor, unless you have specific questions. Prior to the semester starting, you may schedule an appointment by searching “College of Nursing” in “Advising Offices” at the top of the LoboAchieve.unm.edu home page.
