



## Resolving Holds at UNM

- Registration for UNM classes cannot be completed until all holds are resolved.
- Use LoboWeb to check on any holds you may have:
  - a. Login to my.unm.edu using your NetID and Password
  - b. Access LoboWeb
  - c. Within LoboWeb, select the “Student” tab followed by “Registration and Records”
  - d. Select “Registration (Add/Drop), Course Search, Check for Holds”
  - e. Click on “Registration Portal” followed by “Check My Registration Status”
  - f. Select “Student” and “OK”
  - g. Select the term and click “Continue”
  - h. The “Prepare for Registration” page will let you know if you have holds or other issues that affect registration
- Please have your UNM ID number ready when contacting any UNM office.
  - “Incomplete Admissions” submit final transcripts to [UNM Admissions](#)
  - “Bursar” hold contact the [UNM Bursar](#)
  - “Orientation” hold register at [New Student Orientation](#)
    - **PLEASE NOTE: ONLY REGISTER FOR THE “COLLEGE OF NURSING DUAL DEGREE BSN” ORIENTATION. If you do not see this as your UNM Orientation option, check back in a few days. It is a manual process to connect students to this fully online option.**
    - Please note this hold is a UNM requirement and is not related to the orientation offered by the College of Nursing via Zoom.
  - “Advisement” holds will be resolved by College of Nursing advisors as part of our internal process. You do not have to meet with a CON advisor, unless you have specific questions. Please do not meet with EPAC advisors to resolve this hold.
