



## Resolving Holds at UNM

- Registration for UNM classes cannot be completed until all holds are resolved.
- Use LoboWeb to check on any holds you may have:
  - a. Login to my.unm.edu using your NetID and Password
  - b. Access LoboWeb
  - c. Within LoboWeb, select the “Student” tab
  - d. Select “Registration and Records”
  - e. Select “View Holds”
- Have your UNM ID number ready when contacting any UNM office.
  - “Incomplete Admissions” submit final transcripts to [UNM Admissions](#)
  - “Bursar” hold contact the [UNM Bursar](#)
  - “Orientation” hold register for [New Student Orientation](#)
    - ONLY REGISTER FOR THE “COLLEGE OF NURSING DUAL DEGREE BSN” ORIENTATION. If you do not see this as your UNM Orientation option, check back in a few days. It is a manual process to connect students to this fully online option.
    - This hold is a UNM requirement and is not the same as the overview offered by the College of Nursing via Zoom.
  - “Advisement” holds will be resolved by your College of Nursing advisor as part of our internal process. You do not have to meet with your advisor, unless you have specific questions. Prior to the semester starting, you may schedule an appointment by searching “College of Nursing” in “Advising Offices” at the top of the LoboAchieve.unm.edu home page.
  - “COVID Vaccine” holds will be resolved by uploading proof of vaccine or appropriate exemption form to the UNM vaccine verification site. Details, forms, and links found [here](#).
