NM-INSPIRES offers facility access funds that allows users to benefit from the many well equipped biological, clinical and translational resources offered on a fee for service basis by our cores, as well as many other unique, specialized, time sensitive or commercial resources that would otherwise be unaffordable.

Center Members and their research teams may apply for funding (up to \$10,000) at any time. Funds are only to be used for services not covered by external grants. To assure transparency, all approved requests will be public information. Applicants will need to identify the required service and provider and obtain a cost estimate as part of the application.

Applications for these funds should be submitted to Theresa Champion (techampion@salud.unm.edu) with the subject line "Facility Access Funds". Requests are reviewed and responded to usually within 72 hours.
