

## NM-INSPIRES RAPID RESPONSE FUNDS APPLICATION

The far-reaching environment health impacts of natural and man-made disasters underscore the need for research to illuminate the short and long-term impacts of disasters. Such events generate exposures within communities that can be detrimental to human health, and consequently, provide unique, time-sensitive research opportunities investigating how these exposures affect those most affected by the disaster.

The Rapid Response funding mechanism is designed to respond quickly to address time-sensitive disaster response research opportunities. Applications are reviewed by leadership on a rolling basis. Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis by the NM-INSPIRES directors and DR2 Lead. Center Members and their research teams may apply for funding (up to \$10,000) at any time. Requests are reviewed and responded to usually within 72 hours.
