

Admission Requirements

- 1) Completion of PH 101 and PH 102. Grade of C or better is required (not C-). Overall GPA minimum of 2.0.
- 2) Upon completion of PH 101 and PH 102, admission to the BSPH is automatic for students admitted to UNM on or after fall 2020. Students must be in pre-PH status. Student admitted to UNM before fall 2020 must submit an online application at coph.unm.edu.
- 3) Meet with COPH undergraduate advisor. Make appointment on LoboAchieve. Email: dnoriegalucero@salud.unm.edu
