## **Admission Requirements**

- 1) Completion of PH 101 and PH 102. Grade of C or better is required (not C-). Overall GPA minimum of 2.0.

## The following requirements must also be met

- 1) A total of 42 credits of upper division courses (300-level or 400-level)
- 2) Choose an Area of Focus or Minor or 2<sup>nd</sup> major. See advisor for options.
- 3) Between 12-21 credits of electives depending on what is chosen as Area of Focus or Minor or 2<sup>nd</sup> major
- 4) Minimum 120 credits to graduate (if doing dual degree 150 credits minimum is required.)
- 5) All other University requirements as stated in the Catalog
- \*\*COPH allows students to declare a second major or a minor. Please see advisor for details
- $\ensuremath{^{**}}\xspace$  The BSPH cannot be added as a second major to any degree program
- \*\*A grade of C (not C-) is needed for all courses to satisfy the UNM Core and the PH Core. Check with advisor for minor and 2<sup>nd</sup> major for minimum acceptable grade
