Health Careers Academy (HCA) at UNM Health Sciences Rio Rancho Campus, a program of UNM HSC Office for Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion, is an intense and rewarding four-week, non-residential engagement and enrichment program for incoming high school juniors. The program is designed to provide exposure to a wide range of health careers through engagement. The program also provides opportunities to earn CPR and Mental Health First Aid certifications, learn health-related skills, and gain college-success enrichment in math, writing, and other success-related skills

Interested applicants must be New Mexico residents, as defined by the University of New Mexico http://registrar.unm.edu/residency/ and residents of and attend school in Sandoval County. Applicants should demonstrate a commitment to increasing health equity.

Student Eligibility

- NM Resident
- Sandoval County Resident and attend a school in Sandoval County
- Minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale
- Must be an incoming junior (class of 2021)
- Must be 16 years old to participate in the shadowing activities
- For those selected, documentation of a negative TB test is required at orientation

Participation Dates

All accepted student participants are required to attend the program orientation on Monday, May 13. The program will begin on Monday, June 3, 2019 and end on Friday, June 28, 2019. Attendance for all days and activities is expected.

If accepted into HCA, the participants will receive an acceptance packet that must be completely filled out and returned at orientation. However, we ask for accepted participants to *confirm their acceptance and reserve their place in writing via email no later than Friday, May 3, 2019* to HealthSciences.riorancho@salud.unm.edu.

Failure to include any of the supporting documents, not following directions completely, or leaving blank sections on this application form will result in an automatic disqualification. Additionally, failure to meet the April 15, 2019 deadline will result in automatic disqualification. To apply, please complete the entire application.
